Background

Pro - Duffers History

During the late 1950's, a group of golfers from Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, known as the "Del Val" golf club contacted several of their former Howard University classmates who lived in the Washington Metropolitan area, and expressed an interest in engaging in some friendly gold matches (area against area).

The idea caught the fancy of nine D.C. golfers **Mark Brown, Otho Ferguson, Sewel Horad, William Hyde, Hugh Jackson, Mordecai Johnson, Leo Willis, William "Bus" Lofton, and John "Buster" Rector**. Sewell Horad was chosen as leader (president) of the group. Though they had not decided on a name, their purpose was well defined "BEAT DEL VAL". Several months after the first encounter with the Del Val group, Robert Smith and Sewell Horad met a fellow golfer at Norwest Park golf Club who identified himself as a "professional duffer". The next time they met with the D.C. group, they proposed the name "Pro Duffers" as a suitable title for the D.C. golfers. The idea was accepted unanimously, and the group became the PRO DUFFERS GOLF CLUB.

In 1986, the D.C. Pro Duffers began discussing the potential of the group and agreed to focus their attention on a specific goal, not just playing golf and socializing. It was decided that a "Memorial tournament" would be held in memory of deceased members to raise funds to help needy and deserving D.C. high school students interested in continuing their education.

In the future, the Pro-Duffers plan to establish a foundation by using half the funds generated from annual tournaments. The Club's vision for the foundation is to perpetuate scholarships for youth.

The Little Rock Chapter has chosen the Arkansas Foundation for Sickle Cell Support as the charity of the 15th Annual Golf Tournament.

Arkansas Foundation for Sickle Cell Support

The Arkansas Foundation for Sickle Cell Support (AFSCS), formerly known as the Pulaski County Sickle Cell Support Group, is a 501 (c) (3) non-profit organization that has existed since 1998. The purpose of the foundation is to provide educational, emotional, financial, and spiritual support to individuals living with sickle cell disease. In addition to the previously listed services, AFSCS provides access to a network of community resources to support families of sickle cell survivors cope with the challenges surrounding the disease. Since inception, a multitude of individuals have reaped the benefits of the services provided by the Arkansas Foundation for Sickle Cell Support.
